Event Categories:

English Historical = Wooden Longbows. Arrows must be loosed off the hand and bows must not have a shelf. Arrows must be wooden shafts with feather fletching. Plastic nocks are allowed.

Traditional = Bows must be constructed of organic material and can have a shelf. Arrows can be wood or bamboo. Plastic nocks are allowed.

Modern Traditional = Take-down bows etc. No sights or release aids allowed. Arrows can be wood, bamboo, aluminium or carbon. Plastic nocks allowed.

***Cubs are exempt from arrow restrictions in all categories.**

*** Compound bows are strictly prohibited.**
